Meeting Minutes - Dec 11, 2025

- **Meeting Call to Order:** 6:03 pm

- **Motion to adopt previous meeting minutes**

New Business:

- Floor Recognizes: Tanis Mould and Jen Johnson with Questions and Concerns
 - Tanis asked when minutes will be posted, questioning if there was a time frame ex: 24 hrs. The handbook doesn't state a time frame, Shelly stated that we try to post within a week due to reviews and proofing.
 - Question Tanis: Why are there no solos in carnival? Mandy replied to the question that there will be, and not sure where she received the information that there wouldn't be. Yes there are solos in carnival, all star skaters that have a program will get to perform it. An email will be sent out at a later date for confirmation for who's is wanting one in the carnival.
 - Question Tanis: Why are we not having a night show, so the club isn't renting the ice surface for 2 days. Response: It's too much for the club's Can-Skate skaters, too long of a day, in the past many skaters missed the night show. Haven't had a night show for several years. Tanis suggested it's time to bring it back. Have a star skater night show.
 - The board has discussed options in previous meetings and it was decided not this year.
 - An evening show will be something considered for next season. Discussion on the amount of volunteers this takes and volunteers aren't always the easiest to find. Tanis suggested reaching out to parents for help with the night show.
 - Carnival will stay as Saturday afternoon show, Sunday afternoon show
 - Tanis mentioned that send-off should to be a bigger show- suggestion will be reviewed by board (le raffles, concession etc)
 - Suggestion made that the club utilizes star skaters more for the Can-Skate program- having that interaction is good and star skaters are like mentors.
 - Response: Club does utilize star skaters. They are the clubs PA's for CanSkate
 - Volunteer opportunities: Is there enough, there are lots at carnival, it takes many. Suggested looking at volunteer check amounts.

- Tanis suggested reaching out to other community clubs and offer payment/donation ex: grad
- Clarification on facebook post on Nov 18, Tanis posted a question about carnival theme, board removed post due to negative connotations within the thread.
- Tanis stated that rules need to be the same across the board for everyone, consequences for actions.
- Suggestion was made that meeting agendas be posted prior to monthly meetings and maybe offer incentives for people to attend.
 - Board: shouldn't have to make incentives, if parents want to be involved in their skaters activities, our meetings have always been open to members.
- A comment was made by Jennifer regarding the way privates didn't seem to be working, but wasn't sure about suggestions that might work better.
 - Response: Private release date on facebook will be posted to prepare parents, we tried it last month, Jennifer stated that didn't really help. All privates are offered to all skaters, there will be plenty next month as morning skate is Tuesday and Thursday 7:30-8:30am, and Marcy and Brianna will be offering privates on both days.
- Another concern also brought to board: other skaters are interacting with coaches while they are doing privates, and asked if we can rectify this problem. Kari will inform coaches of this concern. If continued, email will be sent out to skaters/parents.
- Suggested that the board posts reminders on the arena boards about not disturbing coaches during privates.
- Asked if paper copies of the newsletter can be sent home with skaters and/or posted at the rink. Also post any other information on a message board at the rink.

- Ordering new popcorn for upcoming Christmas parties
- Sea Cans for Sale at Widesky Disposal
 - Shelly and Denise might go look at it but not sure this should be a purchase yet this year providing Carnival coming up and more coach wages this year etc.
- Facebook Vote completed for Coach's gifts - results will be entered into record- 5- \$100 Love Fort Nelson certificates were purchased for coaches, along with cards, chocolates, and a small plant. Gift cards were purchased for PA's, and Heather and Brianna received cards and chocolates.

 - Olive seconds motion - vote is Yes.

 - Denise and Mandy ordered some prizes for raffles during Black Friday deals.

Test and Comp Report:

- Program building option for next month. Ask the Rec Center if there's any ice time to rent to do program building instead of doing it during private times as we have 7 skaters needing programs. Motion: Sandra, Second: Olive carried
- Upcoming Competitions- registration dates and guidelines. Regionals and GP closed, Totem not open yet, Peace River isn't open yet
- Mock Competition: Facebook votes will be recorded to proceed on the last day of skating. Voted yes to have mock comp on last day of skating Dec 12
- Coach Marcy is attending Regionals and Totem has 20 plus skaters are attending
