

Mile 300 Figure Skating Meeting Minutes - Nov 12, 2025

- Meeting Call to Order: 6:01pm

- Motion to adopt previous meeting minutes Motioned by Olive. Second by Ellie.

Carried President's Report:

- Ordering new popcorn for upcoming Christmas parties - will need to put the popcorn machine together. Previously purchased from the popcorn company. Will look at what previous order was but will most likely order 10 boxes to start.

Registrar's Report:

- Skating total for enrollment is 106 so far! With a few more to add to PreCan.
- Waiting list for this season? 2 on waitlist for Canskate, 2 open precan spots with 1 package sent out to parents so when that is returned it will be 1 open spot.

Treasurer's Report:

- Accounts Summary: General 106721.29 and Gaming 9862.25
- Scotia Bank Closure in July. The club will have to change banks as we need to deposit cash and get floats out of the bank. Two options are BEEM credit union and CIBC. Shelly will get package options from both to vote at in a future meeting.
 - Our accounts are sitting quite good so we need some ideas to spend money on. Nicole suggested a lift for the star skaters. This would require to have someone certified so would need to send someone away to obtain certification. Would also need to check with the town/rec center as this would have to be engineered into the ceiling. We can look into this option.

Carnival Chair Report:

- Purchases for next season
 - Spotlights Have to measure the distance from where we stand & ice surface.
- Would like to purchase something cheap like a light for kids to buy at the concession.

Theme for Carnival? Have an idea but Mandy and Denise want to work out the slogan and advertising first before sharing.

- Shelly will send skater lists to Carnival Chairs to figure out how many songs/numbers they want.

Test and Comp Report:

- Private list verification and sign off approval from the Board. Was approved and signed.
 - December privates – discussed whether to offer to skaters that didn't get as many as some other skaters in previous months. It was decided that it would be a first come first serve as the skaters that got more privates was because they filled in spots that were unclaimed after everyone picked their privates. Send out an email and a post on facebook to announce the date and time the private booking email will be send out so parents can be prepared to check and to keep it fair.
- Seminar outlook for season/competitions wasn't discussed
- Marcy emailed re: Star Skate Christmas Party Would like to have pizza, prizes, secret santa. The board discussed the option of potluck or pizza. Ellie motioned a vote for pizza and a \$100 budget for prizes. Sandra Second. Motion Carried
 - Will look into a sponsored Christmas movie for Precanskate and Canskate kids at the theatre. To include a voucher for popcorn and drink for each skater.

Fundraiser's Report:

- Raffle Booklets update 10 people haven't picked up tickets. Dianne Legge will sit at IGA and sell tickets for us
- Lawrence Meat Fundraiser 15 people fundraised for this. Sold \$15,450 worth and we get to keep \$3,708! Rosenau is covering the freight again this year so we got a \$100 (\$76 our cost) box to say thank you.

Parent Liaison Report: Will get quotes from Promo Shop out of town for the puffercoats. Style Rite was \$40 per logo with us purchasing the coats elsewhere for \$65 each. Vests were \$10 cheaper. Nicole will send out an interested list email to starskate once we have quotes. ***update. Friday Nov 14 – Nicole texted the group to say she heard back. Ladies Jackets are \$80 plus the logo (\$5-\$10 each) WAY cheaper than style rite. Youth puffer jackets are \$70 Each. Puffer vests are youth \$45 and adult \$50. She will be drafting up the email and sending it out so we can see how many skaters are interested. Jamie suggested possibly spending some money and gifting each coach 1 jacket for Christmas.***
