New Business:

President's Report:

- **Ice User's Meeting:**
 - All dates other than Carnival March dates have been approved.
 - There are 3 clubs/teams wanting the same weekend in March possibly
 - May need to bring it to a committee and each group will present a letter requisition.
- **Morning Ice:** Mile 300 has requested that Tuesday and Thursday mornings public ice be changed to Figure Skating Public ice in case the opposite morning group would like some unsupervised ice time to practice.
- Shelly motions that Morning skate for the Starskate group should start Sept 14th to allow for more practice versus only a month before competitions.
 - Nicole seconds motion - vote is yes.
 - Kari will discuss with Marcy and Brianna regarding morning skates and coachable time frames.
- NRRM is hoping to recertify employees in early to mid August in ice maintenance.

Registrar's Report:

- Uplifter Program has been started! Ayae will load documents and check into uploading previous returning skaters info so that we can send a link via email for Pre-Registration.
 - Once Pre-Registration deadline is passed the board can open it up to new skater registration to fill the remaining spots if any open.
 - **Any outstanding fees owed will need to be paid in order to register!**
 - **May see a small increase in some fees due to more certified coaches present during lessons.**

Treasurer's Report:

- Accounts Summary: General and Gaming
 - General: \$ 40,042.02
 - Gaming: \$ 7,828.29
 - Shelly provided financials to meeting
 - Shelly motions to prepay ice fees for start up in the amount of \$7000.00 to NRRM from Gaming account.
 - Kari seconds. Vote is yes
- CIBC Change over
 - Running into problems. Cannot get a Debit Visa card therefore the automatic payments are having to be reimbursed to Shelly. Shelly will bring in monthly expenses and banking verification before reimbursement follows.
 - Shelly will contact Lawrence to see if there is another solution for the account so that we can have online payment accessible for Carnival preparations and program supplies etc.
